



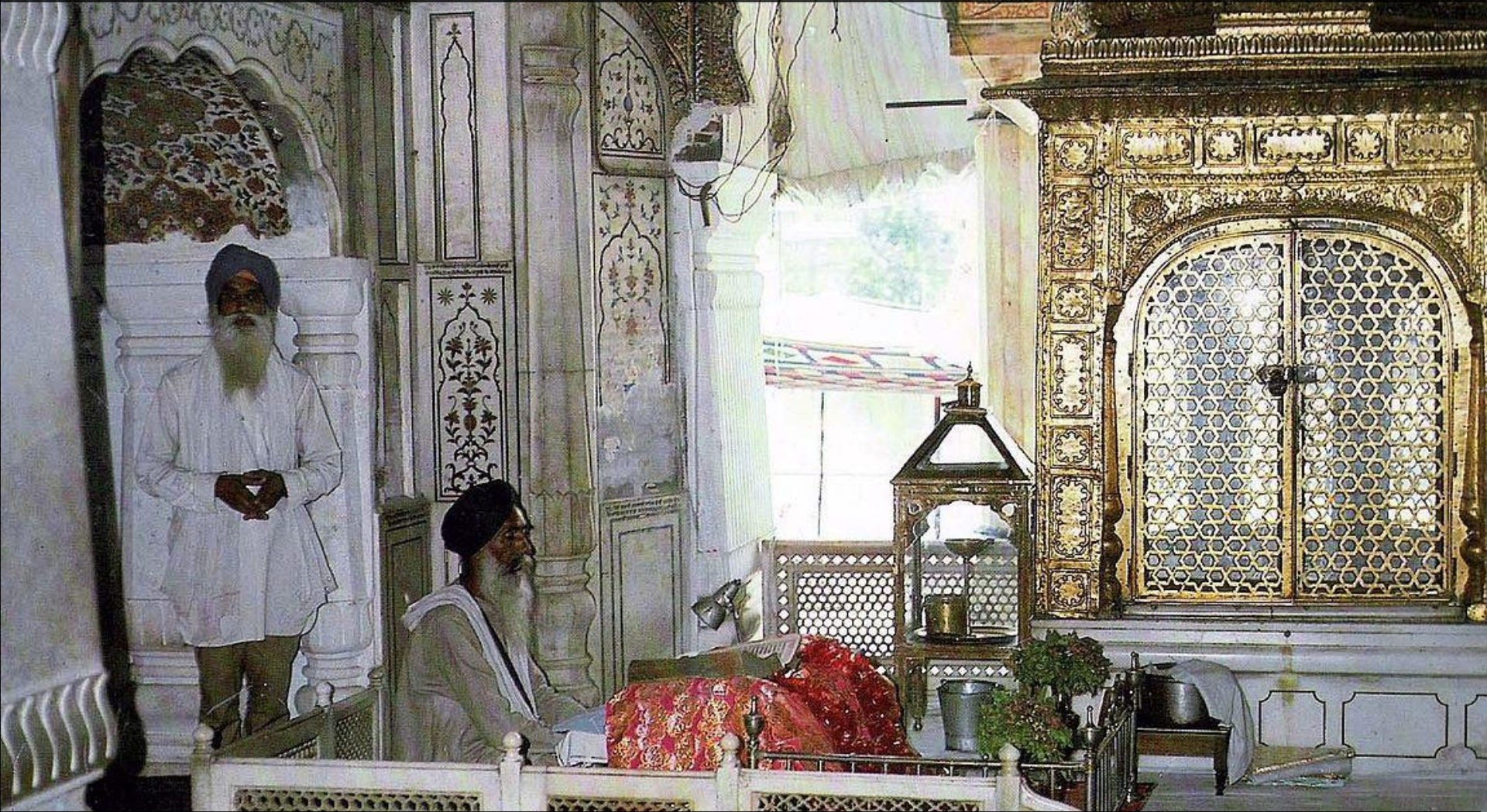
Sikhism and Baha'i

Guru Nanak. Sikhism combines beliefs from **Islam** and **Buddhism.**

Sikhism is located:



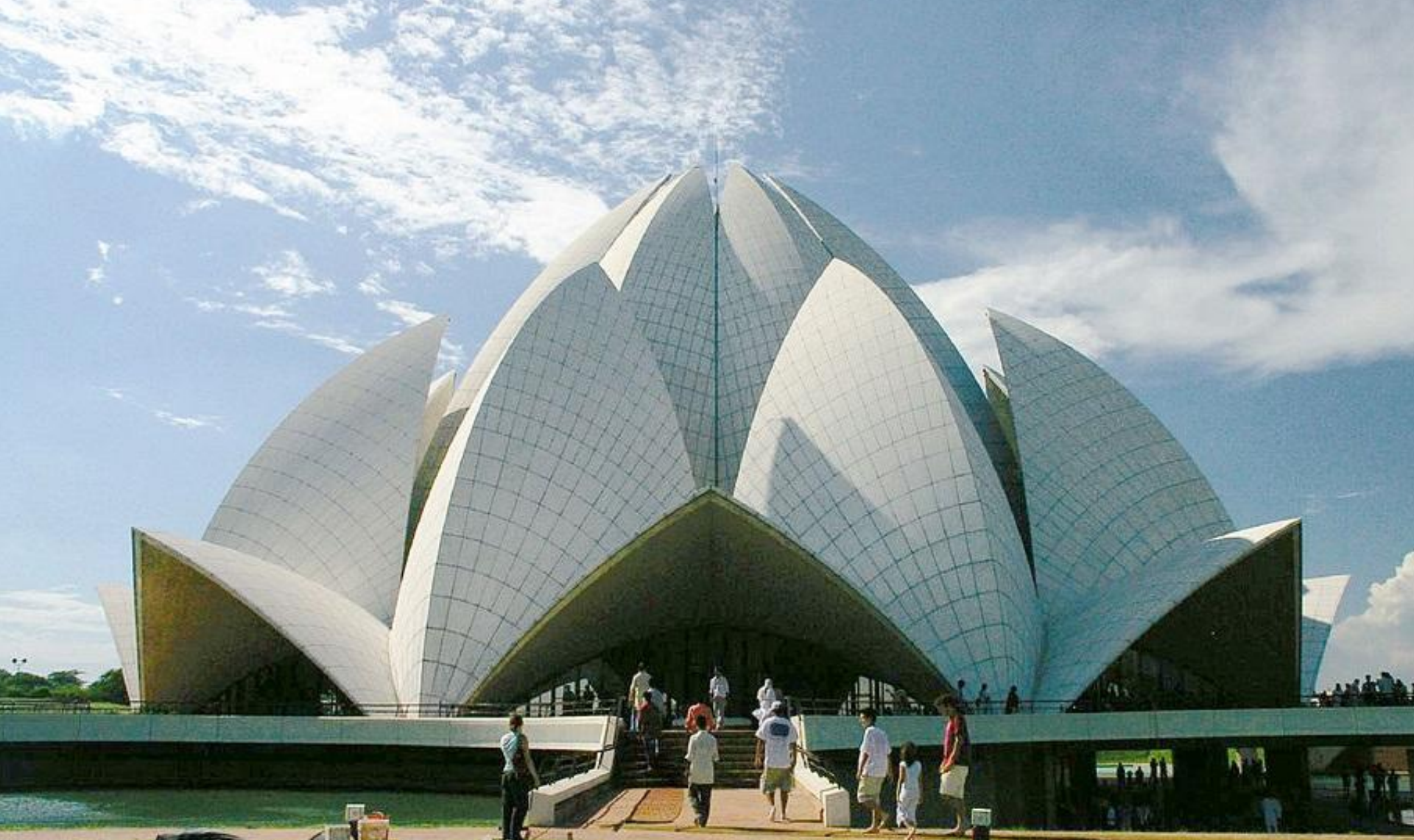
Most Sikhs (21 million) live in the Punjab region of India. Others (3 million) live across the world.

Baha'i believes:



Baha'i emphasizes **Spiritual Unity** among all people. All major religions come from the **same god** and everyone is equally **worthy of acceptance.**

Baha'i was founded by:



Siyyid 'Ali Muhammad in 1844.

Baha'i is located:



Most Baha'i live in Iran.

Ethnic Religions

What is an ethnic religion?



An **Ethnic Religion** primarily appeals to **one group** of people living in **one place**.

Section A: Hinduism

Hindus worship:



Many different gods though most (70%) follow the god **Vishnu** or **Siva** (26%)

Section B: Confucianism and Daoism

Confucianism is:



Located in **China** and characterized not by a belief in a god or gods but by **ethical obligations** to **family** and **society**.

Daoism is:



Located in China. Followers attempt to follow the Tao (Path) or having one's will at harmony with the universe.

Shintoism is:

Judaism is:



One of the oldest religions and the **first recorded **monotheistic** religions.**

Judaism is:



Considered an ethnic religion because of its numbers and because it is generally limited to one ethnic group.

Judaism is:



Located in **many areas** around the world because of the **diaspora**.

What is the **Diaspora**?



The **Jewish Diaspora** was the dispersing of the Jewish people from their original homeland initially by the **Babylonians (586 BCE)** and culminating in the Roman Diaspora after the destruction of the temple (70AD).

Many Jews were forced to live in **ghettos** throughout Europe.





What is a ghetto?



A **ghetto** is a part of a city where a minority group lives because of economic, political, or social discriminations.

Modern Judaism is located:



6 million in the United States, **4 million** in Israel, and **2 million** in the former Soviet Union,

Shamanism is an:



Ethnic religion in which people follow a religious leader or **shaman**.

Shamanism is often expressed through:



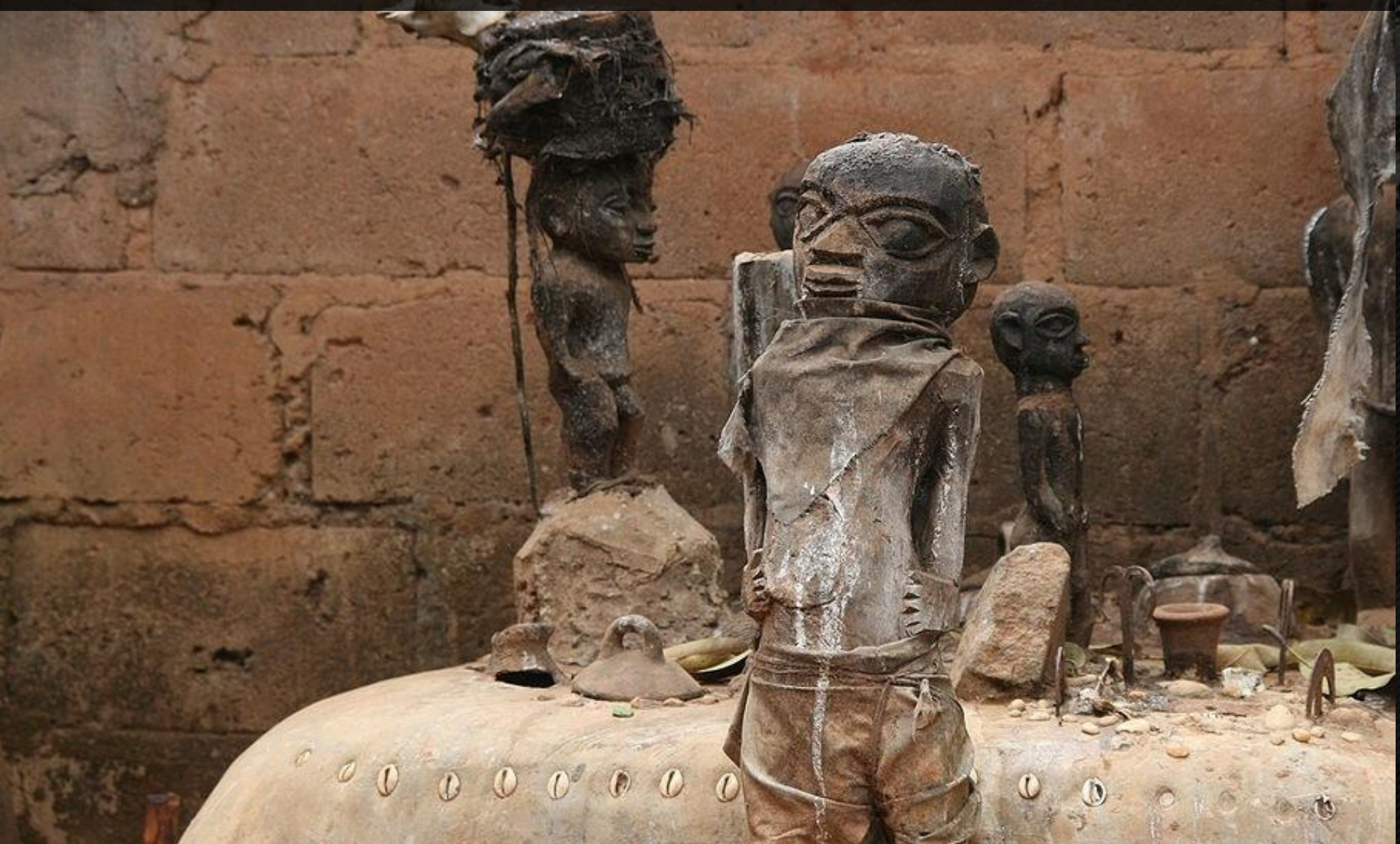
Animism: A belief that all natural objects contain a spirit and conscious life.
